<u>Title:</u> The title clearly directs the reader as to issue the paper will be addressing.

<u>Thesis:</u> The thesis is clearly presented in the introductory paragraph. Without giving too much detail, you successful provide portions of both Kuhn's and Kelly's arguments. By including three specific factors, you direct the reader to the issue you will address as well as provide structure for your argument.

<u>Thesis Support/Argument:</u> Your argument is very well presented and supported. You give multiple examples and textual support for your assertions. Your conclusion successfully ties in the body of your paper without regurgitating your introduction.

## **Mechanics/Specific Quotations to Consider Addressing:**

Besides some fine tuning, the paper reads very well and contains minimal grammatical errors. I would write more suggestions for improve, but it seems as if you have already produced a very strong thesis with sufficient support!

## Page Three:

- Minor Detail: Although what is currently in use is not too abrupt, you may consider smoothing the transition from the cognitive limitations paragraph to the individual rationality paragraph.
- You may want to more clearly define individual rationality so that the reader knows exactly what you mean.
